Early Intervention Services for Youth and Young Adults

Do you know a youth or young adult experiencing significant changes in mood, behaviors, thoughts and/or perceptions?

These changes may be symptoms of early onset psychosis. CHRP provides early intervention support services for youth and young adults to improve cognitive, behavioral, and social functioning.



Rooted in Your Community

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As an early intervention model, CHRP utilizes a continuum of care to provide outreach, psychoeducation, and intervention services to prevent further symptoms. Research has shown that an early intervention approach for those at a higher risk for psychosis improves symptoms, decreases overall disability, and improves age appropriate behavior at home, school, and work.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Children/adults ages 10–25
- Resides in Atlantic, Burlington, Camden, Cape May, Cumberland, Gloucester, or Salem County

SERVICES INCLUDE:

- Individual, family and group therapy
- Individualized treatment plans
- Psychoeducation
- Medication management
- Case management and assessment
