

The Family Support Councils consist of family members of people with I/DD who meet regularly to:

- Conduct public forums and surveys, gathering feedback from families in their area on what is or is not working in the support services they use
- Direct families toward important resources and useful information about the services they need
- Recommend changes to existing DDD/DCF services based on input given by families in their region
- Educate service providers and have them meet face-to-face with families so that they can better understand the needs of the families they serve
- Participate in statewide DDD & DCF committees to advocate for families
- Provide education to families and empower them to participate in improving the system for themselves and others
